**Which PPE do I need for my activity?**

*What matters is which risks employees are exposed to (e.g. chemicals, noise, mechanical hazards).*

**Is CE marking sufficient?**

*Yes, for EU sales. Additional standards help with the correct selection.*

**What happens if I use the wrong PPE?**

*The protective effect may be insufficient – this increases accident and liability risks.*

**How do I recognise whether PPE is still fit for use?**

*Through a brief visual inspection: damage, wear, contamination.*

**How often must PPE be replaced?**

*Dependent on use, stress and manufacturer's instructions – immediately in case of damage.*

**Which PPE is advisable when working with lubricants?**

*Generally gloves and safety goggles, respiratory protection if spray mist is present.*

**Does PPE have to be individual for each employee?**

*Yes, fit and area of use must be correct.*

8

**May PPE be shared?**

*Only if it is designed for this purpose and remains hygienically impeccable.*

**Who decides on PPE selection in the company?**

*The employer – usually in consultation with safety specialists.*
